SUPER 1 FOODS TO PARTNER WITH CAMPUS CUPBOARD

Organization that helps feed U-L students to receive donations from Super 1 Foods

LAFAYETTE, LA – Super 1 Foods has agreed to partner with the U-L Campus Cupboard organization to aid students who will be continuing to stay in the dorms due to the coronavirus pandemic.

This comes after the university moved all classes online, pending the spread of this disease.

Many students were encouraged to move out, but for some, that is not an option and they need to continue to stay in the dorms. U-L President Joseph Savoie says “We understand at this time that some students are just not able to move out of their dorms. While we are offering refunds for those who have moved out, we want to ensure that there are services in place for those who have to stay behind.” While the state of Louisiana is on a stay-at-home mandate, Campus Cupboard is doing its part to provide for those students still on campus, with the help and generosity from Super 1 Foods. They are offering curbside pick-up at this time.

Campus Cupboard is an organization that provides resources for undergraduate students, graduate students, faculty and staff who require short-term assistance meeting their food needs.
